

REASONS TO KEEP YOUR CAT INDOORS

- It is much less likely the cat will be stolen.
- You will be liked much better in the neighborhood.
- Birds will be more plentiful.
- You will not have dead mice brought to the front door.
- There is much less chance your cat will be injured by a dog, or steel-jawed trap.
- There is less chance your cat will be poisoned.
- It is much less likely your cat will be exposed to **Feline Leukemia** and **Feline AIDS Virus**.
- Your cat will not get abscessed from fight wounds.
- Chances will be decreased for fleas, fungal infections, and internal parasites.
- Cats are less likely to be hit by a car when crossing the living room than when crossing a street.
- You will not have to bail your cat out of the animal shelter.
